The renting pilot is responsible for the safe and conscientious operation of the aircraft until it is returned and securely parked at DCT Aviation facilities. The following company aircraft rental policies and conditions apply to each flight.

I, the renting pilot, agree:

- 1. To operate in accordance with all applicable FAA regulations.
- 2. Not to use the aircraft for flight instruction for any individual, unless I am an authorized DCT Aviation Instructor on a specified dual training flight.
- To land only at FAA approved airports that are safe and suitable with hard surface runways.
- 4. Not to authorize or allow any other person to operate or handle the aircraft.
- 5. To telephone DCT Aviation (248-666-1800 or 248-755-3193) if I am unable to return the aircraft at the agreed time for any reason.
- 6. To pay any landing fees, tie down fees, or any other charge incurred by me while the aircraft is in my possession.
- 7. Concerning overnight flights I must request and receive approval from the management of DCT Aviation before putting the flight on the schedule.
- 8. To pay a minimum charge of 3 (three) hours for each day that the aircraft is in my possession, unless prior approval is acquired from management.
- 9. To report all accidents, major or minor to DCT Aviation at once, together with the names and addresses of witnesses and involved parties. In the event of an accident I will not permit the aircraft to be moved unless expressly authorized by DCT Aviation or local, state, or federal authorities and will do all that I can to protect the aircraft and its equipment from further loss.
- 10. To accept the Hobbs Meter reading to the next highest tenth if it is showing. If no Hobbs Meter is installed, the tachometer will be used and the flight time will be computed at 1.25 times the Tach time. Should the starting time be recorded incorrectly, I must bring this to the attention of the flight desk before starting the flight.
- 11. To pay the cost of recovering the aircraft if abandoned away from Pontiac Airport (PTK) including: all transportation expenses for one pilot to the abandoned aircraft, pilot time at standard solo rate for all time recorded on the aircraft while away from home base, and all other costs directly related to this operation.
- 12. To obtain weather reports and forecasts, to file FAA flight plans for all cross-country flights, and to use the aircraft only for this purpose and over the route specified.
- 13. Should I need to purchase fuel for the aircraft, I will have it credited to my account for the amount of my purchase or the current DCT Aviation reimbursement rate, whichever is less, tax included. All purchases must be documented with an original receipt at the time the aircraft is returned.
- 14. To see that the aircraft is securely tied down in a proper area, master and ignition switches off, controls secured, and doors locked.
- 15. To remain current in each aircraft I fly in accordance with FAR's and to have a re-check with DCT Aviation instructor, if I have not flown a DCT Aviation aircraft (1) one hour within the preceding 30 days.
- 16. Do no touch and goes, only full stop landing with taxi backs.
- 17. Do no flying in marginal VFR weather unless instrument rated.
- 18. File flight plan with a Flight Service Station prior to **any** flight over 100 nautical miles. If less then 100 nm, flight plan is not necessary if in continuous contact with flight following.
- 19. Before initiating any night cross country flight, file a flight plan with a Flight Service Station.
- 20. If intend to land at a private field, any grass runway, or a field less than 3,000 feet in length, will obtain the DCT Aviation management permission.
- 21. To accept and abide by the current no show policy of DCT Aviation. If I am unable to fly an aircraft as scheduled, I will notify DCT Aviation at (248-666-1800) at least twelve hours prior to scheduled flight time and update schedule-on-line. If I am more than 15 minutes late for a scheduled flight and the flight cannot be reasonably completed in the remaining time scheduled, then I agree to pay a fine equal to ½ of the time scheduled at the aircraft's normal rental price if solo flight, or ½ of the time scheduled at the aircraft's normal rental plus full time scheduled for the appropriate instructor if dual flight.
- 22. To pay all sales and uses taxes in accordance of state laws.
- 23. Not to either perform or authorize any repairs or adjustments, nor make any purchases in relation to the aircraft without authorization from DCT Aviation.
- 24. To accept liability for any damage done to the aircraft while in my possession not covered by the current insurance policy, i.e. the deductible.
- 25. Not to smoke in the aircraft. If found to be in violation of DCT Aviation non-smoking policy, I forfeit all privileges as a DCT Aviation customer.
- 26. To provide all necessary personal identification as requested by the flight desk including, but not limited to driver's license, passport, and applicable visas.
- 27. To be subject to a background check and associated fees as required by the FAA.
- 28. To maintain aircraft cleanliness by removing all trash from the flight deck. Those found in violation of DCT Aviation clean-up policy are subject to a \$50.00 clean up fee.
- 29. To provide written notice to DCT Aviation, if I decide to terminate Renter Agreement.
